CONDITIONS

This Equivalency Certificate authorizes the members of the Propane Gas Association of Canada, to handle, offer for transport or transport and authorizes any person to handle or transport on behalf of the certificate holder, or to return to the certificate holder, in a road vehicle, dangerous goods that are LIQUEFIED PETROLEUM GASES; or PETROLEUM GASES, LIQUEFIED, Class 2.1, UN1075, in a manner that does not comply with subsection 4.15(3) of the *Transportation of Dangerous Goods Regulations*, if:

- (a) the dangerous goods are transported in a means of containment that displays a placard that corresponds to a placard set out in Part 4 of the *Transportation of Dangerous Goods Regulations*;
- (b) the placard is displayed on each long side of the means of containment;
- (c) the capacity of each portable means of containment does not exceed 10000 L;
