



NEW P•T•I CARDS AND CERTIFICATES

We recently made changes in the production and appearance of our student cards and certificates.

In the past, you have received a certificate with a separate card. In future, the card and certificate will be produced on one sheet of special paper. This allows us to print the document in one step rather than the three steps we previously had to do – printing the certificate, printing the card and matching the two together. This will have a major impact on time efficiency, as we produce over twenty thousand certificates and cards each year. In addition, it will also eliminate the risk of the student receiving the wrong card.

Please note that the wallet card is made of special stock that cannot be ripped or torn, so it will stand up to regular wear and tear.
